




First announcement of the 5th International Workshop on Plasma Spectroscopy (IPS 2012)



IPS 2012 is an international workshop dedicated to Plasma Spectroscopy; it covers all modern aspects of plasma spectroscopy, connecting basic research with industrial applications.

IPS 2012 will be held at "Presqu'île de Giens", a peninsula in the French Riviera, from the 13th to the 16th of May 2012. The workshop will take place in the Belambra conference centre where all participants may be accommodated.

















Scientific program

The IPS 2012 will be the 5th in a series of successful meetings and will bring together specialists from different places who are applying spectroscopic methods for investigations in gas discharges. While the previous meetings have been focused on infrared diagnostics, IPS 2012 will cover all modern aspects of plasma spectroscopy connecting basic research with industrial applications. The main topics of the workshop include all types of spectroscopic methods such as FTIR, ATR, OES, LIF or tuneable diode laser absorption spectroscopy, as well as their various applications for diagnostics of different gas discharges.

With this first announcement, we would like to invite you to attend this workshop and to ask you to prepare a presentation of your current research results in the field of plasma spectroscopy. Due to the limited facilities of the workshop site, please remember to register early.





Venues

The 5th IPS workshop will be held in the French Riviera in the beautiful nature protected area in the Presqu'île de Giens. The IPS 2012 workshop will start on the evening of Sunday, May 13th with a welcome reception and will end on Wednesday

Participants of the IPS workshop who want to make a scientific contribution will be requested to send an abstract to the LOC following the 2nd announcement. In order to publish an article in the proceedings it is necessary for at least one of the authors to be a registered participant. 



Travel information

Giens peninsula and the Belambra conference center are just a 15 min taxi drive from Hyeres-Toulon airport and 25 min ride from Hyeres train station.

To reach Hyeres-Toulon several options are available depending on where you are coming from:

- Hyeres-Toulon airport is a small international airport but with 6 flights/day from Paris Orly.
- **Nice International airport** is reachable with direct flight from most European countries. From Nice train station, direct trains for Hyeres are available.
- **Toulon and Hyeres trains stations** are reachable from many destination with the TGV network. Hyeres is reachable from Paris in 4h20 with a direct TGV.
